Annual Lions Walleye Fishing Derby on Oneida Lake

The Chittenango Lions Club is a not-for-profit 501(c) 4, an 'all-volunteer service organization, whose members work together for the betterment of local, regional, national, and international communities. Lions International, with which the Chittenango Lions Club is affiliated, is the world's largest humanitarian service organization. The Lions motto is, "We Serve".

On opening weekend of walleye fishing in New York State, May 2-3, 2020, the Chittenango Lions Club will be hosting the **42nd ANNUAL LIONS WALLEYE FISHING DERBY ON ONEIDA LAKE**. The Derby draws participants from both the United States and Canada, attracting nearly 2,000 participants annually. During last year's Derby, participants were awarded over \$15,000 in cash and merchandise prizes. In addition, last year, we had a participant catch a \$5,000 tagged fish.

Net proceeds from all Chittenango Lions Clubs fundraising activities, including the Walleye Derby, are donated to numerous organizations and individuals: i.e. Golisano Children's Hospital, Clear Path for Veterans, Upstate Center for Vision Research, preschool vision screenings, eye exams and eyeglass purchases.
